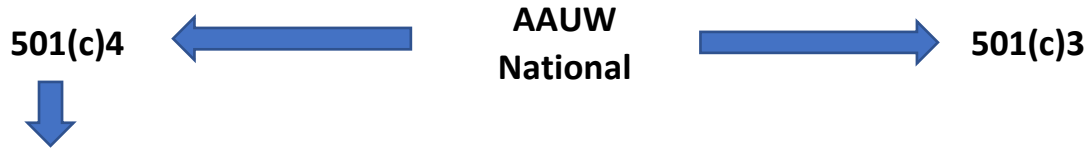


Summary of Longmont AAUW NonProfit Statuses, Relationships and Responsibilities

- Active in politics, lobbying & advocacy work
- Nonprofit status
- Donation are not tax deductible
- **Mechanism for all branches to connect to National**

Branch 1, 2, 3, 4, etc. as a 501(c)4

AAUW Longmont as a 501(c)4

• Social Welfare Organization
• <u>Active</u> in politics, lobbying & advocacy work
• No status with state of Colorado
• No independent nonprofit status with IRS or Colorado
• Donations <u>are not</u> tax deductible
• <u>Secondary</u> status, very limited or no use of this status
• Have agreement with AAUW National
• Branch will take responsibility for filling 990 tax return with IRS by October 15.
• Minor operational connection with National AAUW

- **No Operational connection to branches**

Longmont AAUW Inc. as a 501(c)3

• Religious, Charitable or Education Organization
• <u>Limited</u> activities in politics, lobbying & advocacy work
• <u>Corporation</u> status with state of Colorado
• Nonprofit status with IRS and State of Colorado
• Donations <u>are</u> tax deductible
• <u>Primary</u> , stand alone status for Longmont AAUW
• Have <u>informational</u> agreement with National
• Requires corporation to file the 990 tax return <u>with the IRS</u> by October 15
• <u>No operational connection</u> with National AAUW
